

MAÑES-VINUESA, Jordi

Pharmacy degree from the University of Granada (1976) and Doctor of Pharmacy from the University of Valencia (1980), where he is professor of Nutrition and Food Chemistry since 1991. He has been Vice-Dean (1986-1992) and Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy (1992- 98), director of the department of Public Health (2008-15) and coordinator of the PhD program of Food Science (from 2009) at the University of Valencia. In 2016 was nominated Doctor Honoris Causa by the Universitatea din Medicina si Farmacia of Cluj-Napoca (Rumania).

He is head of the research team of food contaminants since 1985. He has been supervisor of 24 PhD and directed 22 national and international research projects on analysis of drugs and biological fluids, and then, on the presence of chemical and biological contaminants in water and food. He has participated in the publication of more than 300 scientific manuscripts, which have been cited approximately 8000 times and generate an index $h = 50$.

At the present, he is the president of the national network on mycotoxins and toxigenic fungi and decontamination processes of the Ministry of Economy and Competitiveness of the Spanish Government, and member of the Spanish Food Security Agency.
